### **Draft Mauritius Strategy for the further Implementation of the Programme of Action for the Sustainable Development of Small Island Developing States (January 2005)**

The Draft Mauritius Strategy states that Small Island Developing States are now seeking to address the challenges in capacity development through a more integrated approach that includes civil society and the private sector, noting that within the Caribbean Community (CARICOM) region, a charter has been established for the participation of all major groups. The strategy identifies integrating national sustainable development strategies and environmental education within the education systems, with particular support from UNESCO and regional environmental organizations and in the framework of the Decade of Education for Sustainable Development (DESD), 2005-2014. The strategy also recognizes further strengthening the training and teaching of the principles and practices of good governance at all levels and protection of human rights in the islands.
